Due to limited space and late payment, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel registration confirmation.

The withdrawal from participation in the Symposium can be made by the Participant or the Registrant in written form (to the email address: sympozjum@pronovum.pl) no later than 21 days before the date of the Symposium. In the case of withdrawal made in accordance with the rules and within the deadline specified above, the Organizer will refund the fee. The Organizer does not refund the fee if the Participant or the Registrant designates another person in place of the person to whom the withdrawal applies. In the case of withdrawal made after the deadline specified above, the Organizer will not refund any fee already paid, and in the event that the Participant or the Registrant has not paid the fee, the Participant or the Registrant is obliged to pay the full fee despite the submitted withdrawal. Failure to cancel the registration and not attending the Symposium, as well as failure to pay the fee on time, does not constitute withdrawal from participation and results in the Participant or the Registrant being charged the full participation costs.

GDPR INFORMATION CLAUSE

1. Submitting the participation application form and providing personal data is voluntary. Failure to provide the required data will prevent the acceptance of your participation application for the Symposium and the performance of the relevant agreement. Scientific and Technical Services Company „Pro Novum” sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Katowice, is the controller of personal data within the meaning of the Personal Data Protection Act of 10 May 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2019, item 1781, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the Act, and Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as the GDPR Regulation), obtained in connection with its activities related to the organization of the Symposium.
2. Providing personal data is voluntary and is intended for the conclusion and performance of the contract and the proper conduct of the Symposium, as well as for the implementation of information activities related to the organization of the Symposium in the following years. Providing personal data is a condition for consenting to participate in the Symposium, and failure to provide personal data will result in inadmissibility to participate in the Symposium.
3. The Organizer processes the personal data of Participants and Applicants pursuant to Article 23, paragraph 1, points 1 and 3 of the Act, as well as Article 6, paragraph 1, letters a) and b), c) and f) of the GDPR.
4. Personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
 - a) organizing the Symposium and providing information regarding its organization in subsequent years,
 - b) concluding and performing a contract related to the organization of the Symposium,
 - c) conducting marketing and promotional activities related to the organization and implementation of the Symposium.
 - d) fulfilling the Organizer’s legal obligations, in particular tax, accounting, and archiving obligations, as well as those related to the handling of complaints and claims;
 - e) the Organizer’s legitimate interests, including the establishment, pursuit, and defense of claims, internal administrative purposes, maintaining registers of Participants and Applicants, and conducting marketing and promotional activities related to the Organizer’s activities until an objection is filed;
 - f) publication of materials, including photographic, video and audio documentation related to the Participant’s image.
5. Pursuant to Art. 13 section 1 and section 2 of the GDPR, we are additionally informed that:
 - a) currently, no personal data protection inspector has been appointed. Pursuant to Art. 37 GDPR Regulations, if the Organizer appoints the above person to act as data protection officer, the Organizer will provide the data contact details of the data protection officer,
 - b) the data of Participants and Applicants will be stored for the time necessary to implement the tasks specified in section 3 and 4 purposes, i.e. for the duration of the contract, and after that for the period required by law and the statute of limitations possible claims (for the period specified in the Civil Code). To the extent that the legal basis for processing there is a legitimate interest of the Administrator, personal data will be processed until submitted by the Applicant or Participant to object effectively or until the purpose of processing ceases.
 - c) Participants and Applicants have the right to access their personal data, the right to rectify and supplement it, deletion, the right to limit their processing, the right to object to processing, the right to withdraw consent to processing at any time without affecting the lawfulness of processing, the right to data transfer,
 - d) Participants and Applicants have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection (current address: Stanisława Moniuszki 1A, 00-014 Warszawa) when they consider that the processing of personal data violates the law,
 - e) personal data will be made available to entities providing organizational security Symposium on the identification of participants and accommodation facilities.
 - f) personal data will not be transferred to a third country/international organization, g) personal data will not be processed in an automated manner and will not be profiled.
6. By registering to participate in the Symposium, Participants and Applicants declare that:
 - a) they have become familiar with the above provisions and do not raise any comments regarding the above provisions related to the GDPR Regulation and the Act;
 - b) they consent to the processing (including the transfer of data to the entity referred to in paragraph 5 letter e) above) of their personal data by the Controller (Przedsiębiorstwo Usług Naukowo-Technicznych „Pro Novum” sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Katowice 40-534, ul.
